WE CANNOT ACCEPT

- Air conditioners and large appliances such as refrigerators, washers, dryers, ovens, dishwashers, and microwaves

- Armoires

- Bed pillows
- Broken or damaged items of any kind
- Ceiling fans
- Computer equipment
